Program Objectives

Within one year, Michelle's Place will provide 375 resources to cancer patients within the FRHD. These resources will include wigs, prosthesis, hats, scarves, support groups, financial assistance, transportation, oneon one support, etc.

Within one year, Michelle's Place will host 12 support groups/programs at the Fallbrook Wellness Center.

Within one year, Michelle's Place will facilitate 20 free breast exams and breast screenings to women who qualify.

Program Outcomes/Measurables

This Quarter we hired a new patient navigator specifically for the Fallbrook satellite location. Maria Metzel is a breast cancer survivor, volunteer for Michelle's Place and now staff. She will be at the location Tuesdays and Wednesdays. She will also be in the community at events, speaking engagements and Chamber activities to promote the Fallbrook location and the resources we have. The Fallbrook location provided 97 resources this quarter. We have made progress toward our objective of providing 375 resources to cancer patients. Maria will help spread the word and help more people. Our first support group will be held this month. It will be a hybrid in-person and zoom. This effort moves toward the objective of hosting a support group monthly. We have not facilitated any screening breast exams or mammograms yet. However, with the connections that Maria is working on, we hope to host a screening event soon.
