Program Goal & Objectives

The program goal is to address specific physical and mental needs of cognitively or physically impaired seniors and adults through socialization, physical and mental enrichment activities, and movement exercises. To support and provide respite to our client's informal caregivers.

Program Outcomes & Measurables

Between July and September (Q1), our Adult Day Care served a total of 18 clients, providing a total of 391 days of service. By participating in our program, 18 families were able to take a break while their loved ones received care. Two low-income seniors were also awarded scholarships for two days of service, thanks to the FRHD grant. These numbers represent 78% of the quarterly goal of days attended. In addition, three support sessions were provided through our Caregiver Support Group during this cycle.

What to bring to class: The device you will be using, your iPhone or iPad charger, and your APPLE ID and APPLE PASSWORD.

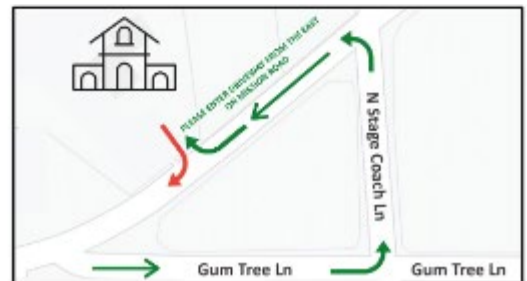

What to Bring to Class: Your desire to learn about internet banking and online bill paying.

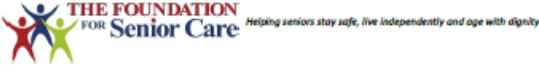

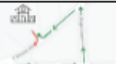
